If it seems fishy, don't bite. Phishing is a scam that uses fake emails (usually from a business or organization you recognize) to trick you into providing personal information. To be safe, don't reply or click on any links in a suspicious email that asks you to provide or update your information.

Should you trust everyone you meet online?

Maybe not. Someone you don't know starts an online relationship with you that eventually leads to a request for your information or money. It's called a Sweetheart Scam. To protect yourself, make sure you know and completely trust the people you add to your account.
